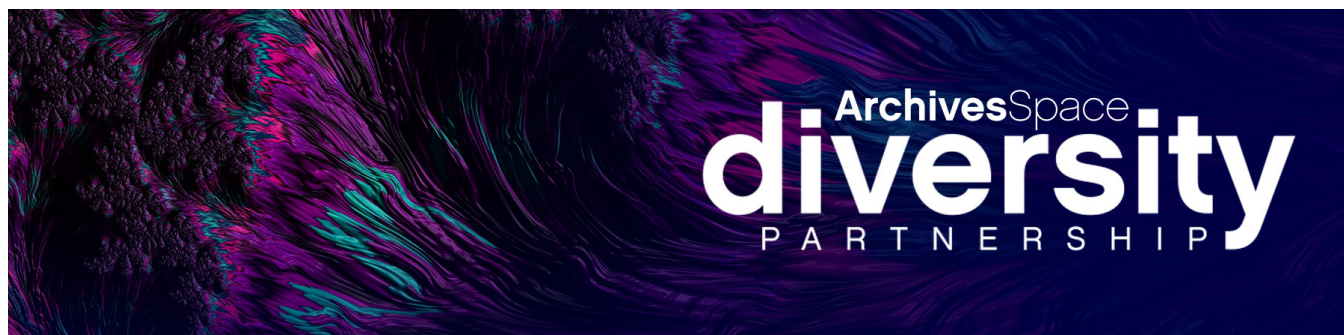


Supporting the needs of an inclusive community

ArchivesSpace continued to support and welcome as many people as possible in FY2020-2021, despite the many challenges the world and all of us in the ArchivesSpace community faced. Some highlights of the year included the first virtual Annual Member Forum, an expanded community-wide training initiative, a reenvisioned program for connecting members called Member Match, and the ArchivesSpace Diversity Partnership, a new community-initiated program offering support to institutions that primarily serve communities currently underrepresented in the ArchivesSpace community. We introduced a new community-authored Code of Conduct and made a commitment to providing captioning for our live and recorded programs. Participation was high across all of our programs and events, with record numbers coming to our webinars, forums, and training sessions.

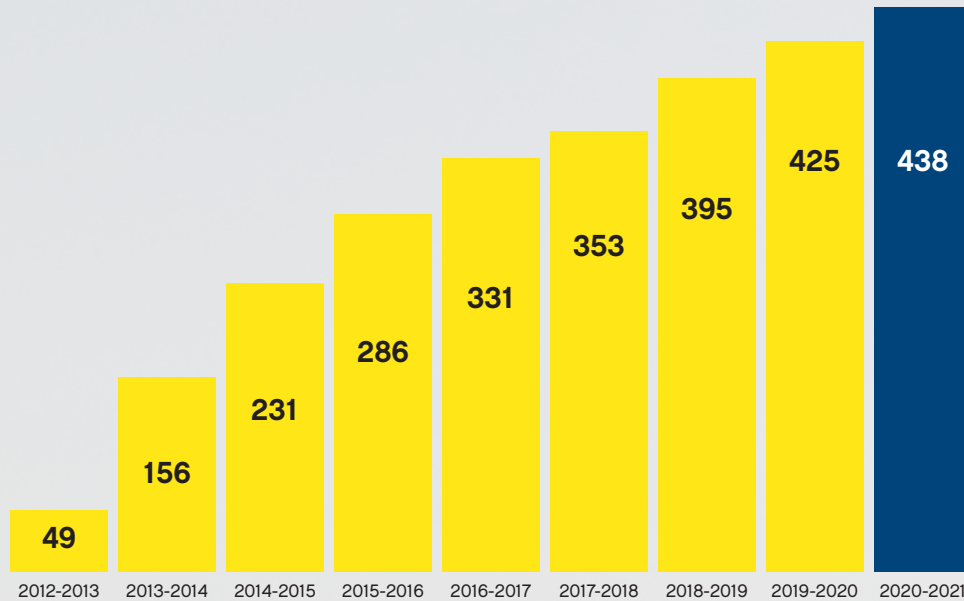
Over **100** hours of community-centered virtual programming, including webinars, trainings, discussions, and forums.

More than **550** Online Forum registrants from **14** countries and **44** U.S. states for **3** days of events.

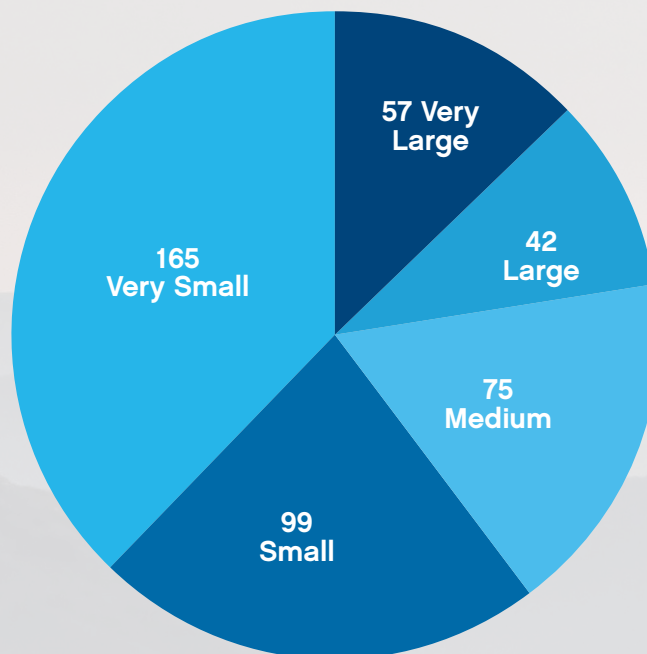


Membership is the Key

Moving ahead on the application

The ArchivesSpace application continued to grow and mature. We put out three new releases, including new features such as merging top containers, more options for preferences, the conversion of the Harvard spreadsheet importer to core code, and a significant expansion to the agents module. We worked with an outside evaluator to conduct an accessibility audit, and we made plans for some major upgrades to the underlying infrastructure of the application in FY2021-2022.
