

# ArchivesSpace Rights Management Enhancement User Stories

## New user stories supported by proposed spec

As an archivist, I want to record machine-actionable rights statements so that I can use those statements to implement access controls in my external discovery system and/or the ArchivesSpace Public User Interface.

As an archivist, I want to record machine-actionable rights statements so that I can build a foundation for reporting on rights data (e.g., on types of statements and on which archival objects are open, which are restricted, which will soon be expiring, etc.)

As an archivist, I want to pass PREMIS rights statements created by preservation management systems to ArchivesSpace so that I can manage them in a human-friendly interface.

As an archivist, I want the ArchivesSpace rights module to be compliant with an international standard so that I can crosswalk to other systems without data loss.

## User stories supported by existing functionality

As an archivist, I want to record DACS-compliant human-readable statements about materials in ArchivesSpace so they can be viewed in the ArchivesSpace public interface.

As an archivist, I want to export DACS-compliant Conditions Governing Access and Conditions Governing Use notes in EAD.

As an Archivist, I want to make sure that I will not lose any previously-entered data in ArchivesSpace.
